**Two North American Stallions Selected by the KFPS in November of 2025**  
**Weard H and Ryker fan Black Earth**

**Testing for the Two Selected North American Stallions**

The two Ster stallions selected to advance in North America are awaiting KFPS scheduling for their under-saddle testing. FHANA expects to receive the schedule and related plans in the very near future. Both stallions are currently training at Elite Dutch Sporthorses in Clarksville, Michigan. If they pass their under-saddle tests, they will advance to a Central Examination in North America this year

Weard H, owned by Lisanne and Andre van der Kooi, was selected by the KFPS in November of 2025 at the Stallion Viewing in Lexington Kentucky. Since that time he has successfully passed the required medical testing which included x-rays, upper airway endoscopy, and semen testing to advance to the under-saddle testing phase. Weard H, Auwert 514 x Fieke H Kroon AA, was born on March 8, 2023, at Mrs. Hageman-Buitenhuis in Dalfsen, Netherlands. Weard's dam is a daughter of Epke 474, his granddam is a Ster Preferent, a Fridse daughter, and his great granddam is a Stb Ster out of Leffert 306. Weard's inbreeding co-efficient is 1.17, his kinship is 18.4%, he was 1.63 m as a 2 ½ year old and is out of mare line 12.



Ryker fan Black Earth, owned by Jo Clough and Dan Malliet, was also selected by the KFPS in November of 2025 in Lexington. He passed the three medical tests, x-rays, upper airway endoscopy, and semen testing. Ryker fan Black Earth, Thorben 466 Sport Elite x Wander 352, was born May 8, 2021, in Black Earth Wisconsin. Ryker's dam is a Stb Preferent \*4, his grandam is a FB Preferent \*4, an Ouke 313, and his granddam is a Stb

Ster Preferent \*6, out of Jochem 259. Ryker's inbreeding co-efficient is 1.17%, his kinship is 16.64%, he is 1.73 m tall and is out of Mare Line 002.



### **Testing for the Selected Stallions in the Netherlands**

Under-saddle testing for the first group of thirty-eight KFPS stallions selected in the Netherlands took place on June 10 and 11, marking the start of a process that will continue in the coming months. Since then, forty-two stallions have been entered for the second and third presentation days, scheduled for July 15 and August 17. At the final event, the KFPS will announce which stallions will advance to the Central Examination, beginning September 1, 2026, in Exloo.
